Schedule

Entry Fee £5 per class

<u>Class 30</u> Juniors Leader and one or two side walkers

Class 31 Seniors Leader and one or two side walkers

<u>Class 32</u> Juniors One helper (either leader or side walker)

<u>Class 33</u> Seniors One helper (either leader or side walker)

Class 34 Juniors Independently ridden (optional small jump)

<u>Class 35</u> Seniors Independently ridden (optional small jump)

Rules

Riders placed first and second in each class qualify for the National Championships, provided they have achieved 60% or above in total marks.

If they do not wish to attend their places may be offered to 3rd and 4th place riders providing they have achieved 60% or above.

Riders who have qualified for the RDA Dressage Championships in 2016 can not qualify for Countryside Challenge Championships.

All classes are divided into two age groups, **Junior** riders are those who are 16 years of age and under on 31st December 2016. **Senior** riders are over 16 on 1st January 2017.

Horses/ponies may enter no more than six tests at this Regional competition, which must not comprise of more than four in any discipline (i.e. 2 Dressage and 4 Countryside Challenge or vice versa)

A small fence is optional in the independently ridden classes 34 and 35, for these classes a caller MUST stand inside the arena and hold a lead rope in case of emergency. Riders who wish to jump in the independent class must be assigned to an approved Level 2 Showjumping RDA Group

Entries and fees to Carolyn Brown by Wednesday 20th May. Late entries will not be accepted.
On the day riders may compete any time from 10:30am
