It will be considered a condition of application that each person agrees to indemnify BD, its associates, the organizers and the venue against any legal action arising there from.
2. All applications must be made on the correct form available on the British Dressage website Northern page or from Sarah Huntridge and are only accepted by post with the correct fee. Applicant will be sent a conformation email. Applications close **7 days** prior to the start date and times will be issued 5 days prior to the event via email.
3. Any withdrawals should be made in writing/email to the organizer along with a vets/doctors note if applicable.
4. Applications are accepted for one horse per rider.
6. **All applications include a £20 deposit which is non refundable. The full amount must be paid with the application. Any WD's that are made after the close of applications are only refundable if the applicant's space can be filled (at the organizer discretion), *minus the £20 deposit. Any WD's made less than 72 hours prior to the start date are non refundable even if the place can be filled. Applications cannot be transferred.***
7. It is hereby agreed and understood that the organizers will choose the appropriate time & trainer for each individual, from the information given on the application form and/or from the request of the trainer. Riders cannot change lesson times or trainer without the permission of the organizer.
8. Riders **MUST** wear a safety helmet with harness to the current standard as advised by the FEI and BD and must wear appropriate riding equipment whilst mounted.
9. If a rider falls from the horse during a lesson the procedure as per the BD rule book will come in to effect.
10. Any complaints should be made in writing to Sarah Huntridge and will be treated in the strictest confidence.
11. Riders should be available for the duration of the day. Riders should then be available for training from 9am – 5pm.
12. Dates marked with a * are open to all ages. Dates without a * are open to all riders over the age of 18. All riders under the age of 18 years must be accompanied by an adult.
