Action Taken to

Reduce Risk

- Everyone must observe the current Government guidance in relation to social distancing. <https://www.gov.uk/coronavirus>
- Maximum 6 people may attend (this may apply to clinics) and strictly no more than two people per horse - e.g. rider and helper (if not from the same family must stay 2 metres apart) No spectators <https://www.britishequestrian.org.uk/coronavirus/centres-and-training-facilities>
- Maximum 2 horses in the indoor and outdoor arenas
- Parking is strictly at the bottom of the car park near to the arenas and should be conducted to allow adequate social distancing
- RDA will plan extra time between bookings, riders leave promptly after their booking
- Hand sanitiser will be available to be used on arrival before touching any doors, gates and equipment.
- Toilet facilities will be available to use, please follow strict handwashing procedures.
- Booking and payment should be done online or over the phone where possible to reduce contact
- It is a requirement you do not come to Wakefield RDA if you have any symptoms or have been around anyone with COVID symptoms! <https://www.nhs.uk/conditions/coronavirus-covid-19/check-if-you-have-coronavirus-symptoms/>
- Be flexible and able to quickly adapt to any changes in government guidelines
