
Rules

- The organisers accept no liability or responsibility for competitors, spectators, vehicles, property or animals.
- Riding hats must be to the current standard—PAS015/ EN1384/ BSEN1384 with the British standard kite mark & must be fastened correctly at all times whilst mounted.
- Hats must also be worn in all in hand classes.
- Correct footwear must be worn at all times.
- Correctly fitted spurs may be worn by seniors only but not in the novice class.
- Swearing, abusive behavior or excessive use of the whip will not be tolerated and you will be asked to leave the showground.
- Stallions must be handled or ridden by an appropriate person. Judges have discretion to ask you to leave.
- Any complaints should be reported to the secretary/entries box and put in writing within 20 minutes off the class with a fee of £20 which will be refunded if your complaint is up held.
- No cantering or galloping on the show ground except in the warm up area and show ring.
- All rider/handler ages are taken as of 1st January 2015.
- Horses/ponies must be at least 4 years of age if competing in any ridden class. An equines age is the age it will become during the current showing year.
- Lorries/trailers must not be mucked out onto the field. Please take all rubbish home with you.
- Please keep dogs on a lead and under control at all times.
- WRDA reserve the right to cancel, amend or amalgamate any class at this show.
- No refunds will be given once a class has been entered or if you miss your class.
- The judges decision is final.

- 2 Youngstock 3 years and under
- **3 Novice Horse/Pony** (In their first show season. No age restriction)
- **4 Mountain and Moorland** (Open but may split if sufficient entries)
- 5 Coloured (Piebald, skewbald, spotted dun, roan & palomino)
- 6 Cob (Hogged or in natural state)
- 7 Veteran (15 years and over)
- 8 Race Horse to Ridden Horse in hand

Championship class for winners only from In Hand classes 1-8.

The Honeyman Hull trophy will be presented to the In Hand Champion

Ring 2 - 11.30pm start

- **9 Child Handler** (Riding Hats to standard must be worn, no adults in ring)
- **10 Bonny Pony** (Handler under 16 years old only)
- 11 Fancy Dress (Rider must wear hat to standard)
- **12 Handsome Horse**
- 13 Best Six Legs
- 14 Roundest Bum

Ridden

Ring 3 - 10am start

Judge will break for lunch around 12.30

- 15 Tack and Turnout
- **16 Lead Rein** (Rider 10 years and under, pony not *to exceed* 12.2hh)
- **17 First Ridden** (Rider 12 years and under, pony not to exceed 13.2hh)
- **18 Novice Ridden** (Not to have won first in any *show class. No cantering in show ring all together, only in individual show)*
- 19 Ridden Pony (14.2hh and under)
- 20 Ridden Horse (14.3hh and over)
- **21 Ridden Mountain and Moorland** (Open may split if sufficient entries)
- **22 Ridden Coloured** (Piebald, skewbald, spotted, dun, roan & palomino)
- 23 Ridden Cob (Hogged or in natural state)
- 24 Ridden Veteran (15 years and over)
- 25 Race Horse to Ridden Horse

Championship for winners of all Ridden classes 15 - 25 The Hugh Langford Memorial Trophy will be presented to the Ridden Champion
