#### Dear friends.

Welcome to our third Wrda newsletter. We hope to keep you informed about news, events and activities here at Wakefield RDA and to invite everyone to support us by getting involved in some of the events we are planning this year.

Our Events and Fundraising Committee was formed in 2012 to help organise social and fundraising events. Money raised from fundraisers such as Quiz Night, Race Night, Annual Show and Dressage Events bring in much needed funds to support the Charity.

You may not be aware - but our group does not receive any government or local authority funding! and fees from riding lessons and education programmes alone do not cover the day to day running costs, therefore we constantly have to raise additional funds in order to continue to deliver our excellent quality of service to the local community, ensure the welfare of our horses and maintain our facilities.

Here is an idea of some costs each year:-

Produce hay and haylage, purchase straw £2506.00
Licenses & memberships £ 698.00
Equine dentist, farrier & vet £2540.00
Insurance £3373.00
Routine maintenance/utilities £1454.00
